Extending analysis skills to other INDEPTH HDSS members

• A workshop involving 16 HDSSs was then organized in Accra; June 2009 on clustering of mortality.



Outcome

- Dodowa's paper was published in May 2010 in TMIH
- Nine centre-specific papers are included in this supplement.
