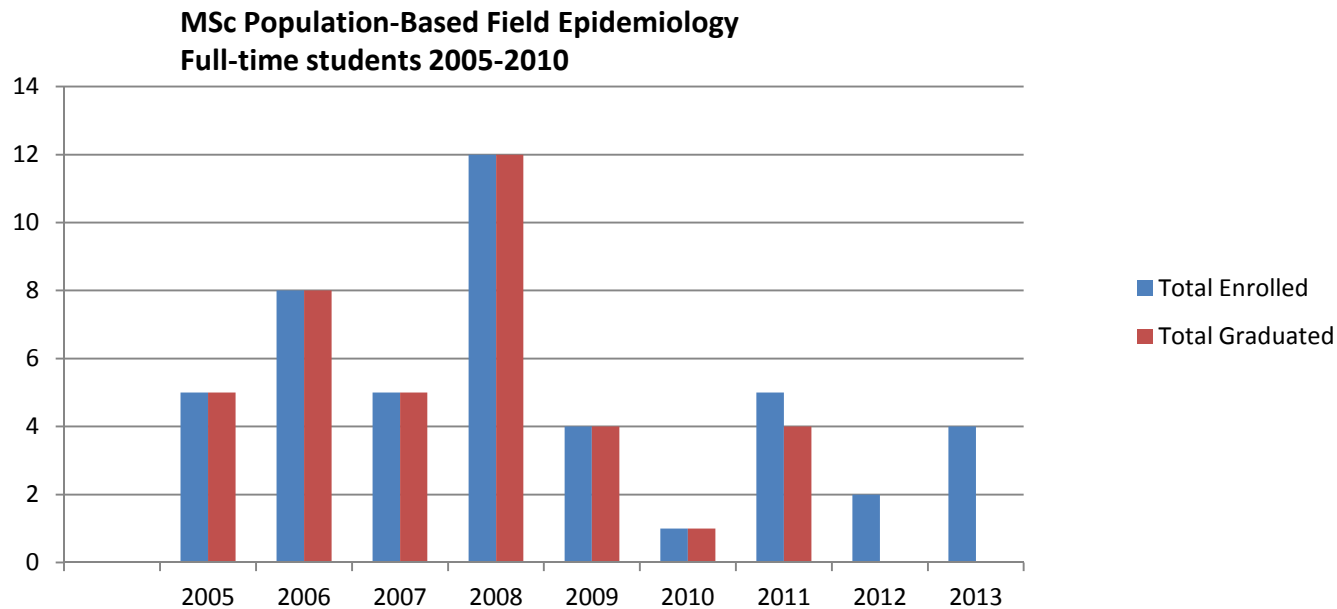

INDEPTH-WITS Partnership

- Partnership from 2006
- Started MSc in Population Based Field-Epidemiology



Impact of INDEPTH-Wits training to-date: 2011

- Publication output – 17 alumni produced 53 publications, 8 first author, all indexed
- Resource for Africa as *all* students go “home”
- Progression to PhD studies 5/35 (12%)
- Progressive investment by Wits University – 5 new posts since 2005 sustainability

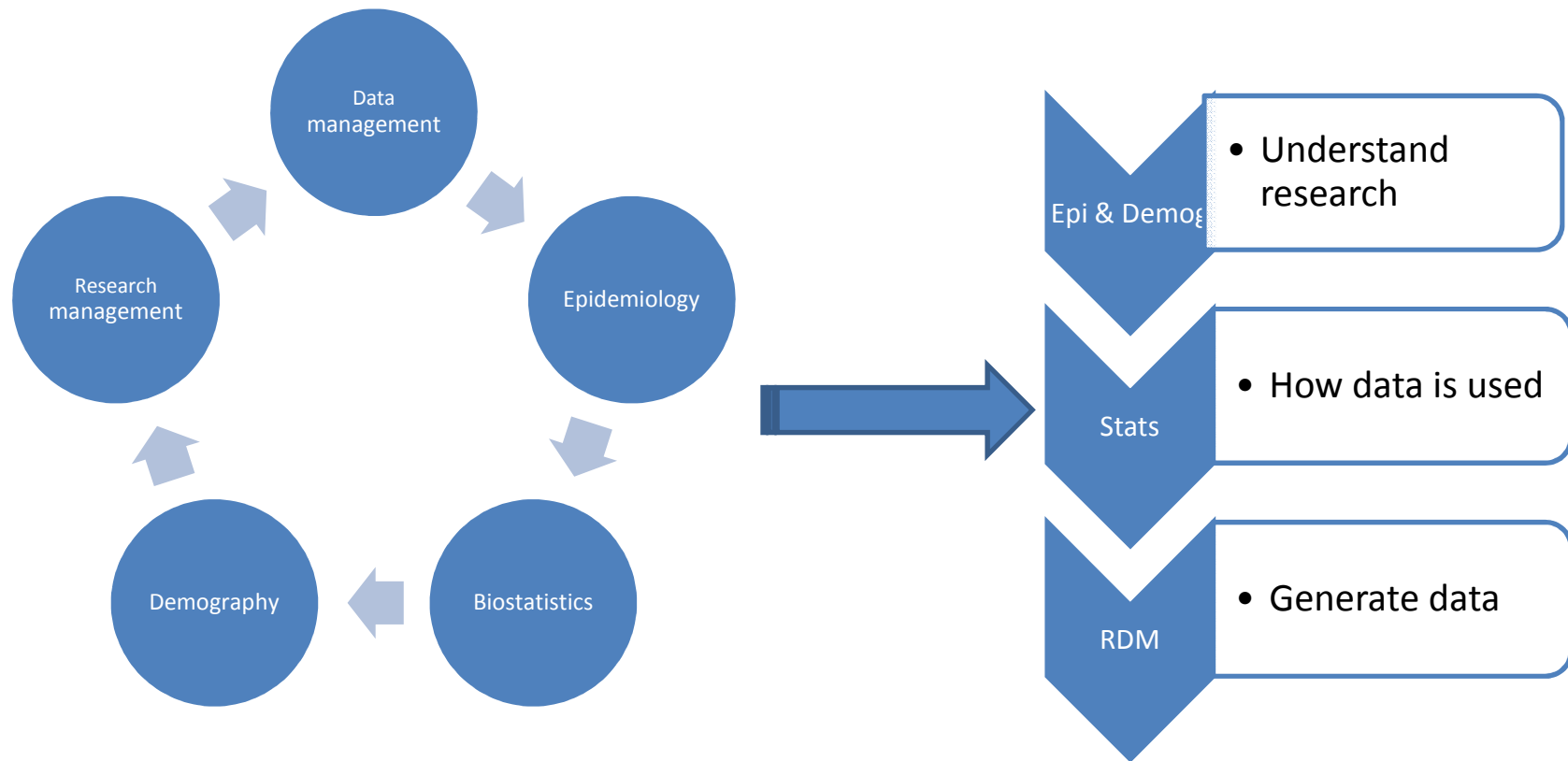
Rationale for new programme in Research Data Management

- Limited skills in advanced research database management
- Need to increase and strengthen this capacity: expressed need by students and HDSS leaders
- Research data managers should be part of the scientific process
- Need for a career pathway in order to retain staff in research centers

New programme

- Masters degree in Research Data Management
- Accreditation with Wits University 2012/23
- Short course piloted in 2013
 - Longitudinal Data and Event History Analysis
 - 19 participants
- Degree programme offered from 2014

General content



- Cost effective as builds on previous knowledge
- Acknowledges scarce skills while emphasising interdisciplinarity
- Not just “techies” but people who are research-oriented data managers
- Longer-term aim to create a pipeline for PhDs and post-docs

Structure of degree

- 18 month programme
- Coursework in year 1
 - 16 courses
- 5 month field attachment at an affiliated INDEPTH Centre
 - Undertake research report

Status of applications and staff

- Appointed a senior lecturer to run course
 - PhD in Computer Science
- 9 applicants to-date (not all INDEPTH)
 - need 10 students to run programme
